- Student academic day: 8:30 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.
- Before and After School Care for working families (Space is limited): 7:30 a.m. - 8:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m.
- Transportation is *not* offered for this program. You must provide transportation.
- Your child must be 4 years old by Aug. 1, 2023.

You will be notified when it opens.*). OMWPK provides FREE pre-K to those families who qualify. (Limited grant scholarships are available for those who do not qualify.)
